


Hereinafter called as to "THE AUTHOR OF THE TRUST OR THE FOUNDER OF THE TRUST"

WHEREAS the AUTHOR and Founder Trustees are desirous of establishing a Trust for public charitable objects and whereas the Trustees have, at the request of AUTHOR, agreed to act as the first Trustees of these presents as testified by their being parties to and executing these presents.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follows:

That, in order to effectuate her aforesaid desire, the AUTHOR (Ajit Kumar) has set apart and handed over to the Trustees, a sum of Rs. 51,000/- (Fifty One thousand only) where as the AUTHOR of the Trust Possesses absolutely own cash which are valued 5,000/m is desirous to establish a public charitable Trust of assets previously inafter called the Trust Fund which expression shall highed cash and any other property or investments of any kind whatsoryer into which the same or any



part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time or which may be acquired by the Trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the Trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the Trust objects to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

- 1. Name: The name of the trust shall be "S.D. Educational Foundation & Welfare Trust", (Hereinafter know as Trust). The trustees may change it. If they mutually so decided in future.
- 2. Registered Office: The registered office of the Trust shall be located in Paliganj at Patna district and at present shall be placed at Vill.- Dharhara, P.O.-Paliganj, P.S.-Paliganj, Dist.-Patna (Bihar) and it can be changed at such other places as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.
- 3. Area of Operation: The operational area of the Trust shall be whole India and may be reduced as the Trustees may decide.
- 4. Administrative Office, Branches or Project Offices: Trust may have administrative office or branches or project offices in such place or places as decided by the Chairperson of Trust or Board of Trustees time to time within the operational area of the Trust under the overall guidance and control of the registered office.
- 5. Funds of the Trust: The assets, together with all further donations, contributions, grant and loan in any shape of form made to the said trust from time to time, and the rents, profits and income thereof and the stocks, funds and properties representing the same shall be held by the Trustees upon Trust for the objects and purposes and subject to powers and provisions hereinafter set out.
- 6. Objects of the Trust:

Trust will extend its services without discriminating the caste, creed, race and religion but special emphasis will be on educationally backward in particular and weaker sections in general. The objects of Trust are to:

To open, run and continue a primary, secandary and senior secandary school for the education of boys and

girls and develop character of the students as well as to educate them on a balanced and broadly based eurriculum which promotes the spiritual, moral, cultural, mental and physical development of pupils, besides knowledge instruction which prepares the pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life.

6.2 To establish, run, develop and management of hospitals, medical schools and colleges, pharmacy and dental colleges, nursing institutions, para-medical, health education institutions, polytechnics, industrial training institutes/industrial training centre, dispensaries, maternity homes, technical or non-technical institutions like Information Technology & Engineering colleges, management institutes, child or women welfare centres and/or such similar institutions in India for the benefit of the general public.

6.3 To Open, run, Develop and manage, assist and support Schools including boarding school from primary to university level, Colleges, libraries, reading rooms, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public

in general.

5.4 To establish, run, develop and manage studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students (including supply of books, Stipends, medals and other incentives to student without any distinction as to caste, colour, race creed or sex.


6.5 To promote, establish, run or manage higher educational institutions for the promotion of science and technology, management, literature, music, drama and fine arts in India for the benefit of the public in general.

6.6 To establish, run, maintain or manage for the establishment and/or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, dharamshalas and rest houses for use by public in general.

To establish, run, maintain or manage shelter homes, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows, aged persons and helpless children.

To establish, run maintain or manage institutions or centres for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally tarded persons and to provide them education loos, clothing or other helps.

To extend relief work and assist to the needy victims

counselling centre, de-addiction centre, day care home, rehabilitation centre. 6.24 To establish, maintain, run, acquire, develop, improve, extent, grant, donate for and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of General hospital, Nursing home, clinic, X-Rays plants, dispensaries, maternity home, recreation centre and all similar institutions. run, maintain, establish, own, manage Rehabilitation centre in the following field: (a) Any type of handicapped persons. (b) Orphans persons. (c) Weaker section/class of persons and Communities. (d) Mentally retarded persons. (e) People suffering from Leprosy. Socially deserted people. 6.26 To charge tuition fee/fees and otherwise recoup themselves for the outlay and expenses incurred in the up keeping and maintenance of institution established or to be established by the Trust. 6.27 To conduct poor feeding and generally give food and relief to the poor needy and disable person and to afford relief work to people in distress due to natural calamity, accident, earthquake, flood, famine, epidemics and grant donation for the support of orphanage and welfare institution and may also carry on rehabilitation programmes. To carry on community development programmes for the 6.28 up-liftment of the economically weaker section of the society and also construct and develop community centre or hall for earrying such activities. Provide consultancy, placement and advisory services, undertake all acts, deeds and things connected with incidental to and germane to the aforesaid objects. **Board of Trustees:** The Trust shall be vested in a Board of Trustees (hereinafter called the Board) which shall consist of not less than five and not more than seven trustees. The first Trustees constituting the Board are: Mr. Ajit Kumaran Mr. Shangan Kumar Mr. Sunnylat Komar, Mrs. Nitu Kuma Mr. Shashi Kum

7.1 The Board of Trustees shall have one Chairperson. The First Chairman of the Board will be Mr. Ajit Kumar and he will continue as up to time of her death, incapacity, insolvency or refusal to actas. The chairperson of the Trust shall be elected by the board of Trustee amongst themselves only by special majority if needed. He/She will be the Chief Executive Officer of the board and shall have the power to do all acts, deeds and things to carry out the aims and object of the Trust.

The term of all other trustees shall be of five years.

- 7.2 The first trustees constituting the Board shall have the power to increase the strength of the Board by appointing thereto one or more person on the recommendation of Chairman whether on the same occasion or on different occasions, as trustee or trustees, but the total number of persons constituting the Board shall at no time exceed seven.
- 7.3 In the event of vacancy in the office of chairman, the Board shall elect a Chairman amongst themselves.
- 7.4 If any of the Trustee shall die, or desire to retire, refuse or become incapacitated to act as a Trustee or take the benefit of insolvency Law, then and in every such case, there shall be a vacancy in the Board.

 7.5 A Trustee may be recomb to the board.

.5 A Trustee may be removed from his office in the following grounds

(i) if the trustee becomes unfit or personally incapable to act in the trust:

(ii) if found guilty of (a) misconduct or abuse of office, (b) acting dishonestly or fraudulently, (c) misappropriation of trust funds, (d) moral turpitude, (e) application of trust property to private purposes etc.

A Trustee may be removed by a resolution adopted by two third majority of the members of the Board present and voting at a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Trustee affected shall be given reasonable opportunity to show cause against the proposed action.

MENT (VINEY)

Vacancies in the Board may be filled by the remaining Trustees at a meeting called for the purpose. Casual vacancies if the Board may be filled in the manner aforesaid for the three purpose of the term of the Trustee causing the vacancy. A netiring trustee shall be eligible for re-election on the recommendation of Chairman.

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MENT (THEY)

The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be 1/3rd of the existing members. If the meeting have not a quorum within one hour of the fixed time, the meeting shall be adjourned to the same day and time at the same place for the next week. Adjourned meeting shall not require having a quorum.

Vacancies in the Board shall not invalidate the any of the

proceedings of the Board.

7.9 The Board may meet as often as necessary but not less than twice in a calendar year and their proceeding shall be recorded regularly in minute's book to retain for purpose. In any resolution to be passed touching the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent however for the Trustee to decide matters by circulation. In case there being equality of votes, the chairman of the meeting has casting votes for the purpose of deciding the issue.

7.10 Decisions at the meeting of the Board shall be taken by the majority of the trustees present by unanimous decision or voting. In the case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the

Board shall have a second or casting vote.

The founder shall also be one of the trustees during his life and after the death the eldest male member of his family shall be a co-trustee.

7.12 The trustee may frame rule and regulation as to the duties and responsibilities of each Trustee, to appoint sub committees with the administration of the Trust and its management.

7.13 The managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee so authorised by the board of trustees shall have the custody of all the document, deeds, titles relating to the Trust properties and investment, and the book of account and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible to the preservation of the same.


7.14 Notice shall be served personally or sent by post to the Board of Trustees seven days prior for all type of meetings.

Power and Functions of the Board of Trustees:--8


8.1 To accept any donation, contribution, grant, loan or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of Persons or Trust, Govt. Semi-Govt. department or agency, bank, national or international donor, with or without

conditions.

To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust Fand or accumulations thereto, to anyone or more of the objects of the rust, as the Trustees may, in

their discretion, deem fit from time to time. 8.3 To convert and deal with the Trust property and/or any investments for the time being. 8.4 To invest the Trust-Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, Stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Trustees. 8.5 To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also to lend money either with or without security. 8.6 To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust-Fund. 8.7 To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust-Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think cfit. 8.8 To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust-Fund. 8.9 To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or-investment. Subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit. To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and 8.10 regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust. To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or 8.11 charitable institutions for the benefit of the general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them. To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the 8.12 income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or-part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust. To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, 8.13 abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned hereby. The account or accounts of the Trust shall be opened by the name of the Trust and/or branches, project offices centres or institutions run or conducted by the Trust with a Nationalized or Scheduled bank or other bank approved or permitted by Reserve Bank of India or in Post Office and it shall be operated by one or more of the Trustees or such person authorized by Board of Trustees time to time.

The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a 9.2 Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountant that will be appointed by the Board of Trustees with the

consultation of the chairman.

The audited accounts of the Trust shall be adopted at the 9.3 (meeting of the Board of Trustees called for the purpose and remuneration of Chartered Accountant or Firm of Chartered Accountants shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

Power to amalgate: 10



11.1 The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such money, stocks, funds, deposits and securities as they shall actually receive, not withstanding their signing any receipt for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable or accountable only for their own deliberate or wilful acts of omission or commission.

11.2 No Trustee stall be liable for any breach of trust committed by the Co-trusice except in a spect of his own act and in of any property m his custody.

The Trustees of these Present are entitled to be-reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust-Fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trust and the powers of these present.

Allowance to Trustees & Office-bearers:

If at any time any Trustee acts as a whole time office bearer of the Trust or renders any special service, the Board of Trustees may in its discretion pay such remuneration or allowances to such Trustee as it may think proper.

14 Accounting year of the Trust:

The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.

15 Amendments:

This Trust, Trust-Fund and the provisions relating to the appointment of the first Chairman of the Board are irrevocable. Subject as aforesaid the terms of this deed may be amended, altered or modified by a majority of 2/3rd members of the Board present and voting in a meeting called for the purpose.

Provided, however, that no amendment contrary to the objects of the Trust hereinbefore set forth shall be valid and effective.

16 Interpretation of the terms of this deed of Trust:



The competent court in Patna (Bihar), shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide any question regarding the interpretation, and construction of this Deed or administrative of the Trust and the relate matters. In the event of such courts, having concurrent jurisdiction with any other courts or courts in respect of any claim or dispute against or the Trust or Trustees or any other matter
